## PACKED WITH AROMAS AND FLAVORS

These are wines of aromas and flavors that typify their sense of place in a pretty much inconceivable way. The labels are a treasure trove of information about the wines and their birthplaces, replete with physical landmarks and historic events to that pique and fulfill the curiosity of a true wine lover's sense of adventure. After all, what is wine all about? Discovering how little you know and how much there is to learn. Taste on, my friends, and treat your palates to something inconceivably beautiful.

"From half a dozen vineyards in the southeastern Washington, hails this lip-smacking Cabernet, doused with a few grape seasonings. Indeed, the composition is interesting: 88% Cab, 5% Merlot, 2% Syrah, 2% Grenache, 1% Mourvedre, 1% Cinsault, 1/2% Counoise and 1/2% Petit Verdot, all ripened to achieve generosity of fruit and intensity during a warm vintage. Packed with aromas and flavors of cherry jam, coffee, s'mores, allspice, pleasing hints of pepper and spice and firmly integrated tannins, this wine will have you saying, 'It's inconceivable that a wine could be this yummy.'"
